Stalls Reservations and Assignments: Stalls are purchased online at sherrycervi.com. Shavings are available to purchase online as well, and anytime onsite during the race. Onsite purchases can be made with check or cash only. If you are going to be arriving outside normal check-in hours, please TEXT Pam Bound at 608-692-5050. The Garwood Arena is a complete facility offering lots of amenities. All Stalls are fully covered and enclosed. Stalls are mandatory for Junior and Senior division youth race entries.

Horses are NOT allowed to be tied overnight and must be in stalls. **1 bag of shavings is required and is included in the stall fee.** Outside shavings are not allowed per Garwood Arena rules! All stalls will be pre-assigned prior to arrival and pre-purchased shavings will be in your stalls. **No overnight tying to trailer or setting up of portable panels. No EXCEPTIONS!**

If you prefer stalls and/or RVs beside friends or family, ONE person must purchase them online.

RV Spots/Hook Ups: There should be plenty of RV hook-ups, but we recommend you reserve one by purchasing online prior to arrival at www.sherrycervi.com. Again, if you are arriving after hours, please text Pam 608-692-5050 prior to arrival.

There is NO tying horses at trailers in RV spots, or anywhere on gravel. Zero tolerance for tying horses to trailers on any gravel areas, for any amount of time. All Youth Race contestants must purchase a stall. If you are driving in and out, and do not need a stall, you must park in a designated areas as marked. There is a daily haul-in fee of \$25, if you do not have a stall (Friday warm up race or Saturday peewee).

Coggins & Health Certificates: The state of Ohio requires a Health Certificate within 30 days of coming across state lines, but is subject to change. Please refer to the State for current guidelines and requirements. Annual Coggins is required.

Tack Store: Rod's Western Palace will be set up with a full tack offering.

Veterinarian & Farrier: We will do our best to have a veterinarian and farrier onsite, but not guaranteed.

Arena Set Up & Warm-up: The competition arena will feature a holding pen and closed gate. Riders MUST be in the holding pen the drag before their run. There will be designated warm-up areas accessible to all contestants.

Exhibitions / Time Only's: Time-Onlys will be available for purchase Wednesday and Thursday before the race (exhibition schedule subject to change). Riders will be allowed 60 seconds and one time through the pattern only. Check the Facebook page and event schedule for times.

Drags: Small Drags will occur every 5 riders, and big drags will take place every 50 riders.
